ALL GENERAL AND BEEF RULES/POLICIES APPLY. ADDITIONAL SIMMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. All Simmental entries must be accompanied by a Registration Paper with the American Simmental Association or the Canadian Simmental Association. Females under 12 months or bulls under 15 months may be accompanied by a completed application for registration. All animals must be purebred as specified by the Association or at least 50% Simmental and combined with Angus to meet the purebred standard (e.g. a ½ Simmental, 3/8 Angus). Animals must be the property of the exhibitor at the time of the opening of the Exposition.
2. Oregon Simmental Association requires all females eighteen months or older must be pregnant, and a test may be required. Also, all bulls eighteen months or older are subject to semen testing and reproductive evaluation.
